Diversity, Intercultural, and Community Engagement (DICE) Certificate Program Health Sciences Scholars

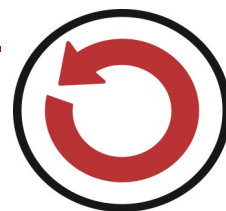
DICE is a certificate earning program for all students interested in enhancing their Ohio State experience through co-curricular involvement focused on diversity, social justice, and leadership. DICE provides diversity training through flexible, fun, experiential learning and serves as a unique way of supporting student identity and interpersonal development. Earning a DICE certificate is a great way for students to show future employers or graduate/professional schools that they had a vested interest in diversity and social justice during their time at Ohio State.

The Student Life Multicultural Center has partnered with the Health Sciences Scholars to create a tailored DICE program specifically for HSS students. Based on your **full participation in HSS programs**, to earn your DICE certificate, you must earn a total of **6 DICE credits and turn in a final reflection paper by April 13, 2018**. There are three levels of options to earn DICE credits listed below and you can earn your credits however you'd like. EARN CREDITS WITH THESE OPTIONS:

Column A

*Each of these options earns you
1 DICE credit*

- Attend a program hosted by the Student Life Multicultural Center
- Attend a Social Justice Engagement (SJE) Workshop
- Attend an Alonso Family Dialogue Series program
- Attend an Advocates for Inclusion and Diversity through Education (AIDE) student org meeting
- Complete a Community Kits reflection journal (*can only complete this option once*)

Column B

*Each of these options earns you
2 DICE credits*

- Attend an entire bias awareness Open Doors training session
- Attend an entire LGBTQ Safe Zone training session
- Attend a minimum of six Sustained Dialogue meetings
- Host or facilitate a program on a topic of your choosing
- Complete a special project with DICE Program Coordinator approval

Column C

*Each of these options earns you
3 DICE credits*

- Earn a final grade of no lower than a "B" in ESHESA 2577
- Attend The Revolution social justice retreat
