### B’Nai Keshet

This group of Jewish LGBTQ and allied members works to create a safe space within the OSU Jewish community where people can come together for socializing, learning, and broader acceptance (listed as ‘Jewish Queers and Allies’).

### Bi The Way

A club for bi/ pan/ polysexual/questioning individuals and allies. This club isn’t technically an organization yet, but it meets regularly and you can find them on twitter: @BiTheWayOSU.

### Gamma Rho Lambda (GRL)

An all-inclusive sorority dedicated to creating a safe space in which our siblings can engage in self-expression and personal growth in a supportive and nurturing environment.

### LGBT & Allies in Medicine

A diverse organization of GLBTIQ and straight medical students who support each other and work to educate the medical school community. We are committed advocates of LGBT patients, an invisible minority that is often left unrecognized and sometimes openly stigmatized by medical institutions.

### Out in Business - Fischer

### Out in Social Work

### SHADES, Buckeye Chapter

SHADES aims to engage people of color at various stages of coming out, understandings of their identity, and make sense of the LGBTQ community. Public events can be attended by allies, but general meetings are designated for queer and trans people of color.
