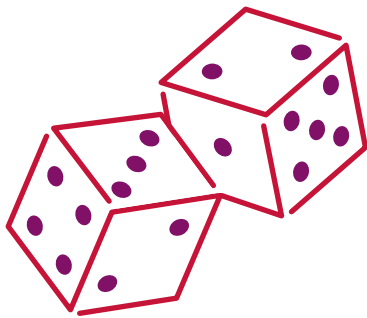
DIVERSITY, INTERCULTURAL AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT *Certificate Program – Health Sciences Scholars*
